But, as you know when Mr. Hanegraaff converted to Eastern Orthodoxy a few years ago, we were very concerned. We decided to separate his conversion from our participation as contributing writers in the publication as long as we did not see false doctrines filter into the writing.

However, in the most recent issue (45-02/03) issue, we are very much in disagreement with his article on page 62. We looked on CRI's website and see that the same issue was brought up in a September 26, 2022 article as well that represents the entire ministry.
